Font Comparison

Here is how the characters look in various commonly used fonts. You will notice some subtle differences. Your computer will probably already contain some of these fonts, so try them out for yourself as you type!

Note: "ti" as in "Kai ti" means "style" or "font." Among these fonts, "Song" is the most commonly used printing font. Almost all Chinese books printed in Mainland China use "Song ti."

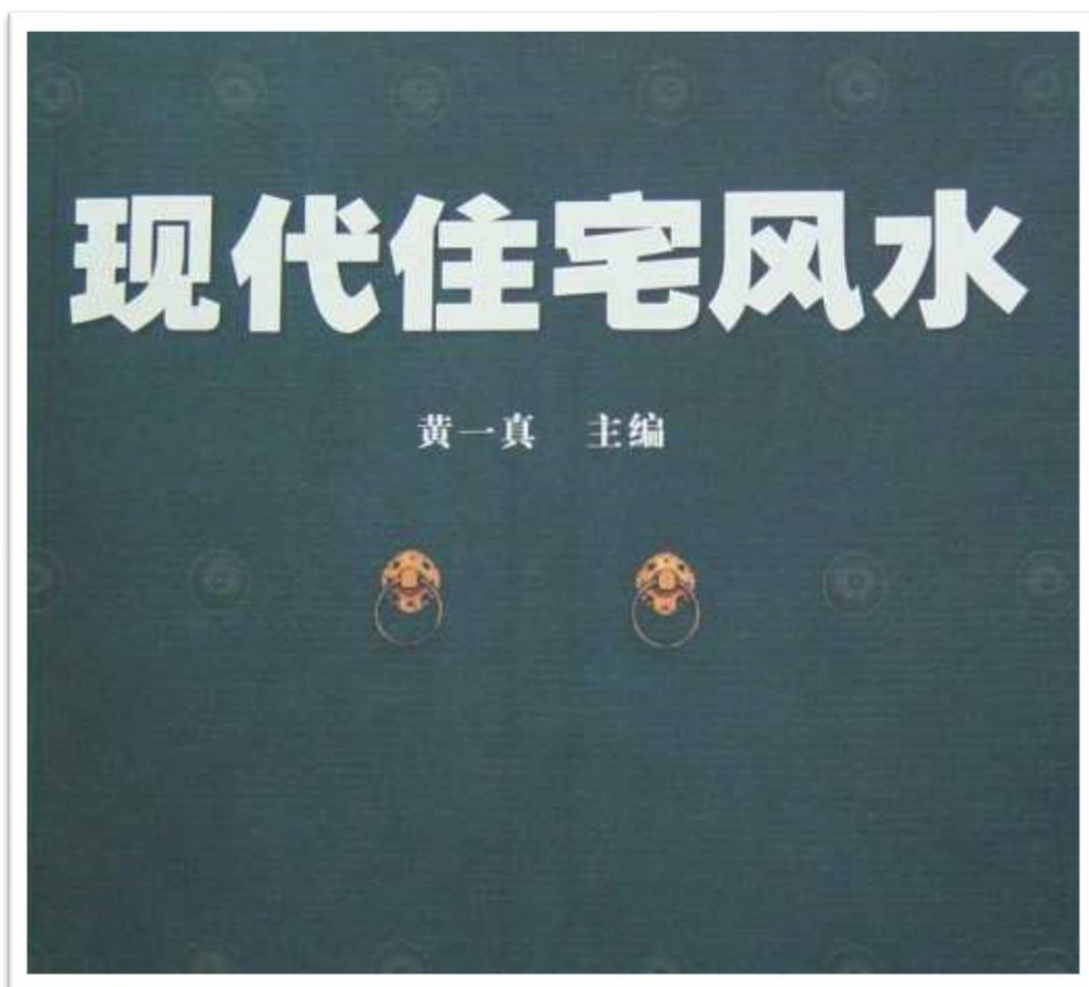

Answer Key for Reading Comprehension

1. 你会中文吗？我只会 tīng、shuō, 不会汉字。

Do you know Chinese? I can only understand it and speak it. I don't know Chinese characters.
(Lit. You can Chinese ma? I only can listen, speak, cannot Chinese characters.)

2. 全 guó 十八岁 yǐ 上的人口有多少？

How many people are there over the age of 18 in the country?
(Lit. Entire country 18 years old and over's population have how many?)

3. 你住 zài 这里多久了？我住 zài 这儿应 gāi 有二十多年了！

How long have you lived here? I have lived here for probably more than 20 years now!
(Lit. You live here how long now? I live here should have 20 more years now!)

(A CCTV program promoting the concept of "happy life".)



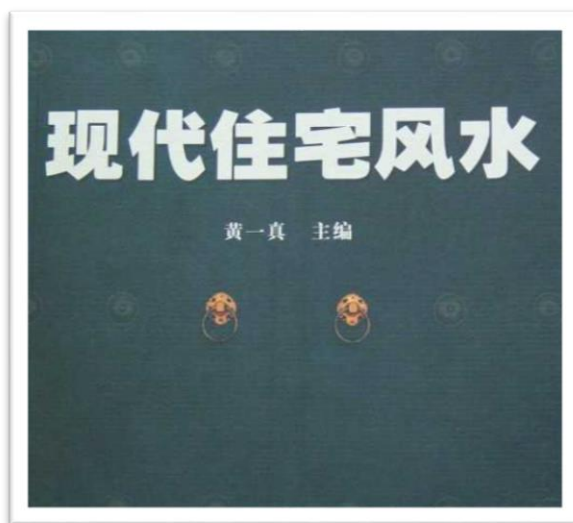
