



#### **Answer Key for Reading Comprehension**

A: 昨天你去北 jīng 了? 那儿的天气怎么 yàng? 去哪 wán 儿了? You went to Beijing yesterday? How was the weather there? Where did go there? (Lit. Yesterday you go Beijing (le)? There's weather how? Go where to play (le)?)

B: 北 jīng 天气非 cháng 好, 可 shì 我 děi 工作, 哪儿也没去, zài 北 jīng 开了一天会!

The weather in Beijing was great, but I had to work and didn't go anywhere. I was in a meeting all day in Beijing!

(Lit. Beijing's weather extremely good, but I had to work, everywhere didn't go, in Beijing held one day meeting!)
