Note: "Jin" is a unit of weight that's used in China. It equals 1.1 pound or 500 grams. "ting" can also be a measure word as the English word "can" as in "tin can".

Font Comparison

Here is how the characters look in various commonly used fonts. You will notice some subtle differences. Your computer will probably already contain some of these fonts, so try them out for yourself as you type!

Note: "ti" as in "Kai ti" means "style" or "font." Among these fonts, "Song" is the most commonly used printing font. Almost all Chinese books printed in Mainland China use "Song ti."

Answer Key for Reading Comprehension

A: 你在中 guó 的时 hou 吃没吃过 KFC? 听朋友 shuō 中 guó 的 KFC 和 měiguó 的 hěn 不一 yàng。

When you were in China, did you eat KFC? I hear a friend say that KFC in China is really different from KFC in America.

(Lit. You in China when, eat-didn't-eat before KFC? Hear friend say China's KFC and America's very different.)

B: 吃过一次。是的,我 jué de 中 guó 的 KFC 比 měiguó 这儿的好吃。 I had it once. Yes, I think KFC in China is better than it is here in America. (Lit. Ate before once. Yes, I think China's KFC compared to America here's tasty.)

A: 你 zhī 道什么叫唱 K 吗? 我还听 shuō 中 guó 人 hěn 喜欢吃完 fàn 后一起去唱 K!

Do you know what "singing K" is? I also heard that Chinese people really like to go "sing K" together after a meal.

(Lit. You know what called sing K (ma)? I also heard Chinese people very like eat-finish food after together go sing K.)

B: 你 zhī 道的真多! 我 hěn 喜欢唱歌,和中 guó 的朋友去唱过几次。 You really know a lot! I really like to sing, and I've gone singing with Chinese friends a few times.

(Lit. You know (de) really a lot! I very like singing, with Chinese friend go sing before few times.)
