*Note: "ti" as in "Kai ti" means "style" or "font." Among these fonts, "Song" is the most commonly used printing font. Almost all Chinese books printed in Mainland China use "Song ti."*



Your girlfriend is really pretty! (Lit. Your girlfriend looks really pretty!)

Flights/airline tickets from Beijing to Shanghai are too expensive!

(Lit. From Beijing to Shanghai (de) airplane tickets too expensive (le)!) )


